It's 'Tuna Masters Teos' O'clock!



In the tournament held for the first time in 2016, the 295-kilogram Bluefin Tuna was recorded as the largest tuna caught in the tournaments held in Turkey in 2017. The team that caught the 190-kilogram tuna won the tournament in 2018. In 2019, a claim was made under the name of "Giants League", drawing attention to it's difference with respect to similar organizations.

This year, the tournament is held under the main sponsorship of Bitci.com and hosted by Teos Marina. Due to the pandemic, guests will be able to enter the organization area named Teos Marina Garden of Eden in a controlled manner on September 2-5, 2021. During the day, the stands of the sponsor companies can be visited. The most exciting part that attracts the attention is when the fish are prepared to be scaled.

THE RESULT OF THE SECOND STAGE WILL DEFINE THE CHAMPION IN ALAÇATI

In Tuna Masters Tournaments held in Teos and Alaçatı since 2019, the winner is determined with the "Tuna Masters of the Year" application. The "Tuna Masters of the Year" team/boat of the year will be determined by considering the fish caught and the points collected in both tournaments (Teos and Alaçatı). The winning team will carry the championship belt for 1 year and will transfer it to the new champion a year later.

Pineapple & Black-eyed Bean Salad on board:

Ingredients: 1 glass of boiled black-eyed peas, 2 slices of pineapple, 2-3 sprigs of spring onions (if available, you can also use 1/2 red onion), 1 capia pepper, 1 green pepper, 1 yellow pepper, a handful of walnuts.

Perfect meal for a perfect summer which is both delicious and healthy to stay fit. It is also very practical to prepare the salad containing dried legumes and fruit. Dice the peppers and pineapple and place in a large bowl. Add boiled chickpeas on it. Finely chop the green onions and walnuts and add them to the salad. If your sun-dried tomatoes are too hard, soak them in boiling water for five minutes and then dice them. Mix all the ingredients. Add some olive oil, lemon, balsamic vinegar and salt to it. Optionally, you can add 1 teaspoon of honey to give it a nice aroma. Bon Appetit...



Agricultural activities possible in underwater farm

The world's first underwater farm, 'Nemo's Garden', has started to produce fruit and vegetables again after a long time.

In 2012, a structure consisting of 6 underwater greenhouses was built by the Ocean Reef Group on the coast of Noli, Italy. In the project, various herbs such as basil, salad, tomatoes, zucchini, beans, green peas, aloe vera, mushrooms and strawberries began to be planted step by step.

"Every year we discover new possible applications for biospheres," says Gianni Fontanesi, Nemo's Garden project coordinator. These include scientific research laboratories or underwater stations for monitoring eco-tourism, fish farming, seaweed farming or wildlife research.

Damaged by severe storms in October 2019, the structure was very close to being brought to a standstill. The team worked to bring life to six air-filled underwater capsules anchored to the bottom of the sea to keep the farm active.

The habitat was left unprotected for months due to Covid-19 restrictions. Yet the structure has held its own, and the farm has reopened more robustly than ever before.



'Life jacket' saves lives on the boat!



A correctly chosen life jacket can save your life by keeping you afloat in any weather/sea condition, even if you lose consciousness, in case of leaving the vessel due to any danger or accidentally falling into the sea. There must be 1 life jacket for each person on the boat.

Life jackets are manufactured to help you stay in the appropriate position where you can breathe by keeping your head up. Adult life jackets are not suitable for children. Life jackets should fit the body and should not slip over children's chin and ears. While wearing the life jacket, make sure it fits your body by fastening all zippers and straps. Remember, "The best life jacket is the one you wear."

When choosing the right life jacket, the weight of the person wearing it, the construction of the life jacket (self-floating, inflatable, mixed) and where it will be used should be taken into account. In general, a person's weight in water is 1/10 of his/her weight on land. For example, a 100 kg person needs an apparatus to keep the 10 kg weight above water. Life jackets should be properly stowed and stored in easily accessible places. It should be able to be worn in a short time in an emergency.

According to SOLAS 74 part III rule 34 of the International Convention for the Safety of Life at Sea, life jackets manufactured in accordance with IMO (International Maritime Organization) rules should be used. When purchasing a life jacket, make sure it meets the International Lifesaving Equipment Code (LSA code) standards.

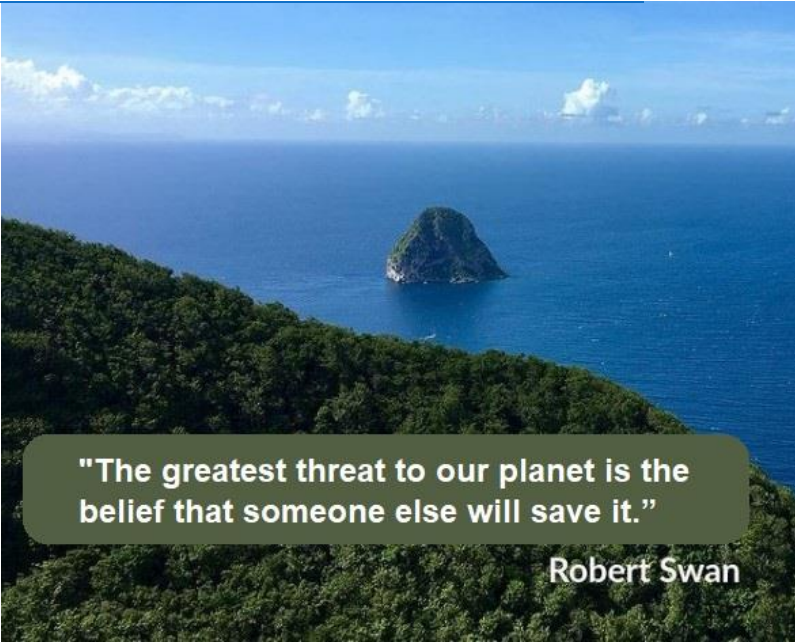
What can we do against forest fires?

As in many parts of the world, fires are undoubtedly one of the factors that endanger the future of forests. Forests are not strangers to forest fires, naturally, fires can break out for many different reasons, such as lightning. However, the human factor increases the number of fires. In accordance with the modern and professional forestry approach, the administration needs to take measures. So what can we do as citizens?

WE AS **TEOS MARINA** **FAMILY**

- We do not exceed the 20 km speed limit on land and 3 nm speed limit on sea in the marina. Life is slow in this quiet city, so slow down.
- In order to reduce our carbon footprint for pedestrians, we encourage walking, cycling and electric vehicles within the marina transportation.
- We do not leave any items such as boats etc. on piers and docks. We don't want them to fly into the sea because of the wind or to prevent the transition of the boats.
- We keep our bays clean and bring our garbage back to the marina. Because we do not want the sea and shores to be filled with garbage.
- We keep common areas clean and we leave the common used materials and tools as we want to find. Because we respect each other.
- We do not leave our garbage and waste oil at the pier entrances and run away. Please keep in mind that we easily determine the people who left them through footages. We take our garbage to the nearest station or waste collection station.
- We do not honk during land and sea traffic. We do not listen loud music. We do not want to disturb the peace of those around us. Because the noise does not suit neither to our peaceful harbor nor Sığacık.
- We do not throw garbage on the ground or into the sea. We separate the garbage for harmony with nature.
- We do not use nylon bags, disposable plastic cup or straws. We reduce plastic waste and protect the environment.
- We do not dive, swim or catch fish in the marina. We act in accordance with the rules.
- We give waste oils and toilet to the licensed firm. We never allow the sea to be polluted.
- We use water sparingly. Because we know the value of even one drop for a sustainable life.



History: Let's get to know the people of Teos with a lease

Teos, the city where the Artists' Union was founded for the first time in history, hosted the Dionysus Artists' Union, which consisted of poets, theater actors and musicians in the 3rd century BC. Poets Anacreon, Antimachus, Epicurus, Nausiphanes, Apellikon and historian Hekataios are among the important philosophers and artists of the ancient era who lived in Teos.

Apellikon, the poet of Teos who lived in the 1st century BC, also had a giant book collection. Traveler, historian and writer Herodotus said of this city 'in the most moderate place in the world'. Excavations continue to unearth the Temple of Dionysus, one of the most important structures of Teos and located within the Hellenistic period city wall, and transfer it to future generations.

A LEASING AGREEMENT WITH 1 GUARANTOR and 6 WITNESSES

The 2,200-year-old inscription, which was found during the excavations in October 2016, is a lease agreement and is very valuable in that it includes legal terms and many details. The 2200-year-old inscription unearthed in the daylight revealed the most comprehensive 'lease agreement' in Anatolia. The contract, signed with 1 guarantor and 6 witnesses, consisting of the notables of the city, also includes penalties to be applied if the land with buildings is not used properly. According to the very detailed lease agreement consisting of 58 lines, written on marble with a height of approximately 1.5 meters; Neos in the 20-30 age group in the city's Gymnasium acquired an inheritance from a citizen of Teos. The person donated his land, which includes structures, slaves, and a sacred altar, to the Neos.

The Neos also rented it out to cover their various expenses and to generate income from that land regularly every year. Who previously owned the land in the inscription? What's inside? All explained. A holy altar is also mentioned. The Neos have even stated that they want to use this land, which is described as 'sacred' in the contract, for 3 days a year. At that time, tax was collected from the lands by the state, but the land was exempted from tax because it was considered 'sacred'. Apparently the land was leased by auction. A bellman was hired and announced to everyone. Some people have applied. Then it was decided who would hire it. The name of the lessor is mentioned in the inscription.

NEOS, NEW CITIZENS OF TEOS

It is known that the concept of citizenship was very important in ancient times and children could get citizenship at the age of 20, provided that their parents were citizens. Neos in the age group of 20-30 were accepted as the most important citizen group of the city because they took part in both politics and people's assemblies and advisory councils and assumed civil service. On the one hand, artists consisting of philosophers, poets, theater actors and musicians; and on the other hand, the new group, more interested in worldly affairs such as politics and city administration, lived together. After a while, the artists community, which was seen as a source of unrest in the city; It is known that he was first sent to Ephesos (Ephesus-Selçuk), then to Myonnessos (Doğanbey) and finally to Lebedos (Ürkmez). The ancient city of Teos, which gained the status of an archaeological site in 2015, has become one of the most frequently visited ruins in the region after Ephesus and Bergama.
